

NEW YORK, Dec 19, 2007 (BUSINESS WIRE) -- The Post Dissolution Trustee ("Trustee") of IMPATH, Inc. and subsidiaries ([IBLTZ](#)) announced that the Internal Revenue Service Office in New York City has recommended approval to the Joint Committee On Taxation, the Committee of the Congress that must approve all refunds over \$2,000,000, of a refund to IMPATH, Inc. and subsidiaries covering the calendar years 1995 through 2005 in the amount of \$22,650,486, plus interest. The Joint Committee must give final approval to the refund. The Joint Committee could seek clarification of certain issues or recalculate the amount of the refund. We cannot say when the Joint Committee will make its decision. In the event that the refund is paid, the proceeds will be distributed to the owners of Class A Beneficial Interests. This is in addition to the State tax refunds which the Trustee seeks to recover.
